### About the Opportunity

Zamorano University is seeking Field Agricultural Technicians to provide direct technical assistance to agricultural producers benefiting from the SAG-Zamorano project. This position will support productivity improvement processes, adoption of good agricultural practices, efficient resource management, capacity building, and technical field follow-up.

### Position Objective

Provide technical assistance, training, and follow-up support to beneficiary agricultural producers, promoting improvements in productivity, agronomic management, efficient water use, fertilization, integrated pest management, production records, and good agricultural practices.

### What You Will Do

- Develop a technical work plan, including schedules for field visits, training sessions, and producer follow-up activities.
- Participate in the identification, characterization, and selection of beneficiary agricultural producers.
- Conduct productive diagnostics of agricultural farms, including cultivated areas, yields, irrigation access, soil management, fertilization, pest control, market access, and current farming practices.
- Provide direct technical assistance in agronomic management of prioritized crops, especially beans and other crops defined by the project.
- Promote good agricultural practices, soil management, moisture conservation, efficient fertilization, integrated pest and disease management, proper use of inputs, and production records.

- Plan and implement demonstration plots, validation practices, and field learning activities.
- Conduct training sessions, field days, and farmer field schools with producers.
- Maintain records of production, yields, implemented practices, technical recommendations, and verification reports with producers.
- Prepare reports for each technical visit, including progress, limitations, recommendations, and supporting evidence.
- Document activities through photographs (process photo records), attendance lists, technical forms, and reports.
- Maintain ongoing communication with the regional lead technician and the project's technical team.
- Support the collection of information for productivity indicators, adoption of practices, and project results.
- Comply with and uphold the policies, procedures, internal regulations, and Code of Conduct of Zamorano University.

### **What We Are Looking For**

- Degree or specialization in Agronomy, Agricultural Production, Plant Protection, Soil Science, Irrigation, or related fields.
- Minimum of two (2) years of experience in agricultural technical assistance, rural extension services, or crop management.
- Knowledge of basic grain production, soil management, fertilization, irrigation, good agricultural practices, and integrated pest management.
- Strong teamwork skills.
- Experience working directly with producers in field settings.
- Experience managing Farmer Field Schools (FFS/ECAs), facilitating training sessions, and working with groups.
- Ability to prepare technical reports and maintain field records.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office and basic digital tools.
- Valid driver's license, preferably with experience operating motorcycles or field vehicles.
- Immediate availability and willingness to travel within the assigned intervention areas.

**Work location:** Project intervention areas (Olancho, Colón, and El Paraíso)

**Estimated duration:** 6 months, with the possibility of continuation depending on approval of a second phase of implementation.
