About the Opportunity

Zamorano University is seeking a Junior Field Technician to support the implementation of technical assistance activities, data collection, activity documentation, producer follow-up, and operational support for the project's technical team. This position will help strengthen the project's field presence and streamline support and monitoring activities for agricultural and livestock producers.

Position Objective

Support the technical team in implementing field activities, collecting information, monitoring producers, conducting training activities, and documenting project progress.

What You Will Do

- Support the planning and execution of field visits to beneficiary producers.
- Assist agricultural and livestock technicians in field activities related to diagnostics, monitoring, and technical assistance processes.
- Support the collection of baseline information, characterization forms, production records, and verification documents.
- Collaborate in the logistical organization of training sessions, field days, community meetings, and farmer field schools.
- Assist with attendance records, photographs, activity reports, and evidence filing.
- Provide basic follow-up support to producers according to instructions from the responsible technician and regional lead technician.
- Support the systematization of field information into databases, forms, and digital project tools.
- Maintain updated physical and digital records, as well as reports from completed activities.
- Report progress, challenges, or field needs to the technical lead in a timely manner.
- Support other technical, logistical, and operational activities required to achieve project goals.

What We Are Looking For

- Graduate of an agricultural or livestock technical high school program, animal production, rural development, or related fields.
- Minimum of one (1) year of experience in field activities, extension services, technical assistance, or agricultural/livestock projects.
- Basic knowledge of agricultural, livestock, or rural development systems.
- Ability to work with producers and interdisciplinary technical teams.
- Strong teamwork skills.
- Ability to collect information, organize documentation, and support reporting activities.
- Basic proficiency in Microsoft Office and digital tools.
- Proactive attitude, responsibility, willingness to learn, and goal-oriented mindset.
- Valid driver's license, preferably with motorcycle driving experience.
- Immediate availability and willingness to travel within the assigned intervention areas.

Work location: Project intervention areas (Olancho, Colón, and El Paraíso)

Estimated duration: 6 months, with the possibility of continuation depending on approval of a second phase of the project.
